ASH WEDNESDAY AT HOME

MAKE YOU ASHES IN ADVANCE

"You can do this by burning strips on paper in a metal tin like a cake tin or a baking tray. Kia tūpato (be careful)

LENT BEGINS

Talk about Ash Wednesday being the first day of Lent which is a time of thinking about God and focusing more on Him instead of the 'stuff' around us. Ash Wednesday is a day when we can say sorry to God and think about our lives.

SAYING SORRY

Talk about what it means to say sorry and why we might want to do that, especially to people we love. How does saying sorry help?

TIME TO THINK

Next encourage the children to think of things they might want to say sorry to God for and give them time to do this privately.

CREATE

- Mix your ashes with oil.
- Create a large cross shape out of paper
- fill a bowl with water
- set out a candle
- put out some paper hearts

SAY TOGETHER

Have one person say the words in the prayer on pg. 3 and ask the rest of the family to join in the bold type words. As they say their line, encourage them to dip their finger in the ash mixture and make the sign of the cross or a finger print on the large cross shape.



PRAY TOGETHER

Thank you Lord that you love us and hear us
when we pray

We are sorry for things we have done that
have hurt you and others.

We have not loved you or others as much as
we could

Lord, we are sorry

We have not helped others as Jesus helped us

Lord, we are sorry

We have been impatient

Lord, we are sorry

We have been angry

Lord, we are sorry

We have been jealous of others

Lord, we are sorry

We have told lies

Lord, we are sorry

We have forgotten to pray

Lord, we are sorry

*Anyone who wants to can add to this
whatever comes to mind.

LIGHT A CANDLE

Have someone in the family say these words while the candle is being lit.

Hear us and help us, Lord
Work through us so that we can share your
goodness and love in the world
Show us the joy and new life that Jesus brings.

Take a heart and exchange it with someone else. Say these words together:

Thank you Lord for loving us
Help us to love one another.
